

The Plantation Ladies 9-Hole Golf Association (PL9GA) was established in 2012 for the recreational pleasure of its adies 9-hole Golf Association, Inc. members bound together by an interest in golf and social

interaction. The PL9GA is comprised of a large and diverse group of women who enjoy all aspects of golf. The goal of the PL9GA is to promote friendship, camaraderie, and sportsmanship in a welcoming environment.

In support of our goal, the association offers organized activities which includes seasonal weekly league play, coordinated group play, special events, recognition of achievement, and a mentorship program to foster new players wishing to develop golf skills. Members play at all levels ranging from the beginner to the experienced player.

## Membership Requirements

Membership in the PL9GA is open to all women who are golf members of The Plantation Golf and Country Club. Our membership is comprised of recreational women golfers who love the game, the outdoors, and the camaraderie. We encourage participation of all women interested in playing golf, regardless of skill level.

Member Benefits

PL9GA members are eligible to participate in all activities including weekly league play and games, special events, Invitationals, summer league and the annual recognition program. In the event a member does not have an established handicap at The Plantation, a temporary handicap will be assigned by the Plantation golf professional. Members are encouraged to establish a handicap as quickly as possible.

**New Plantation Golf & Country Club Members** 

An open invitation is extended to all new Plantation Golf & CC members to join the PL9GA members on the course during league play. New members will be permitted to play in the league a maximum of one time without membership in the PL9GA. This introductory offer enables new members the opportunity to experience league play and become acquainted with the group prior to committing to join the association. New members without an established handicap may participate in the games/prize awards utilizing a temporary handicap issued by the Plantation golf professional.

What the PL9GA offers

Weekly League: Weekly league play for PL9GA members and member guests is scheduled on Tuesdays throughout the season (November-April). Sign up on Golf Genius.

Special Events: Tournaments and special events are coordinated by the PL9GA Special Events Committee. A calendar of events is posted at the beginning of the season.

- Coordinated Group Play: For members that wish to golf on a more frequent basis, group play is coordinated throughout the year by PL9GA members. Tee times are booked in advance and available to players on a first come, first serve basis. Your name will be added to the email distribution list upon receipt of your PL9GA application form. Associated Members are eligible to sign up on their own 4 days in advance of tee time if space is available.
- Recognition Program: One of the goals of the PL9GA is to recognize the growth and achievements of our players in the game of golf. An awards ceremony is held annually at the end of the season. In order to be eligible for an annual award, the member must play in at least one-quarter (1/4) of the play days throughout the season.
- Outside Invitationals/Summer League: The PL9GA is a member of the Lee County Council of Ladies' Nine Hole Golf Associations and, as such, offers its members the opportunity to participate in Invitationals and summer league play hosted by numerous outside clubs.
- Governance: The governing body of the PL9GA is comprised of the elected executive committee members and appointed committee chairs. Any member in good standing may choose to run for office or volunteer as a committee chairperson or member.
